The 236 rooms, including 8 suites and 46 executive suites, are a perfect combination of ancient and modern, tradition and design. Some of the suites overlook the dome of St Peter's. The flooring is a play of marble, fitted carpets and parquet. The furniture is in cherrywood with gold, green and beige finishes. Minimalist silver frames decorate large mirrors. All rooms are equipped with a Starbed, the distinctive mark of Starhotels hospitality and our Pillowmania service, providing à la carte pillows.

Trevi, Bernini and Navona are the names of three of the nine conference rooms, recalling the opulent splendour of Baroque Rome. Situated on two of the lower floors, they seat up to 650 people and, if more space is needed, it is also possible to use the large foyer in front of them. They are all equipped with the latest technology.

The brand new Fitness Room has only one mission: the wellness of our guests. In an intimate and welcoming environment, with a TV and stereo, the room is fitted with
