Location

The Gore is situated between Knightsbridge and Kensington, overlooking Queen's Gate that leads up to Hyde Park.

The hotel is just around the corner from the Royal Albert Hall and a short walk from Kensington Palace, while the shopping Mecca of Knightsbridge, including Harrods and Harvey Nichols, is just a short stroll away.

It is also a five-minute walk from Kensington High Street and the museums of South Kensington, while a short underground journey will take you to the heart of the West End.

Dining

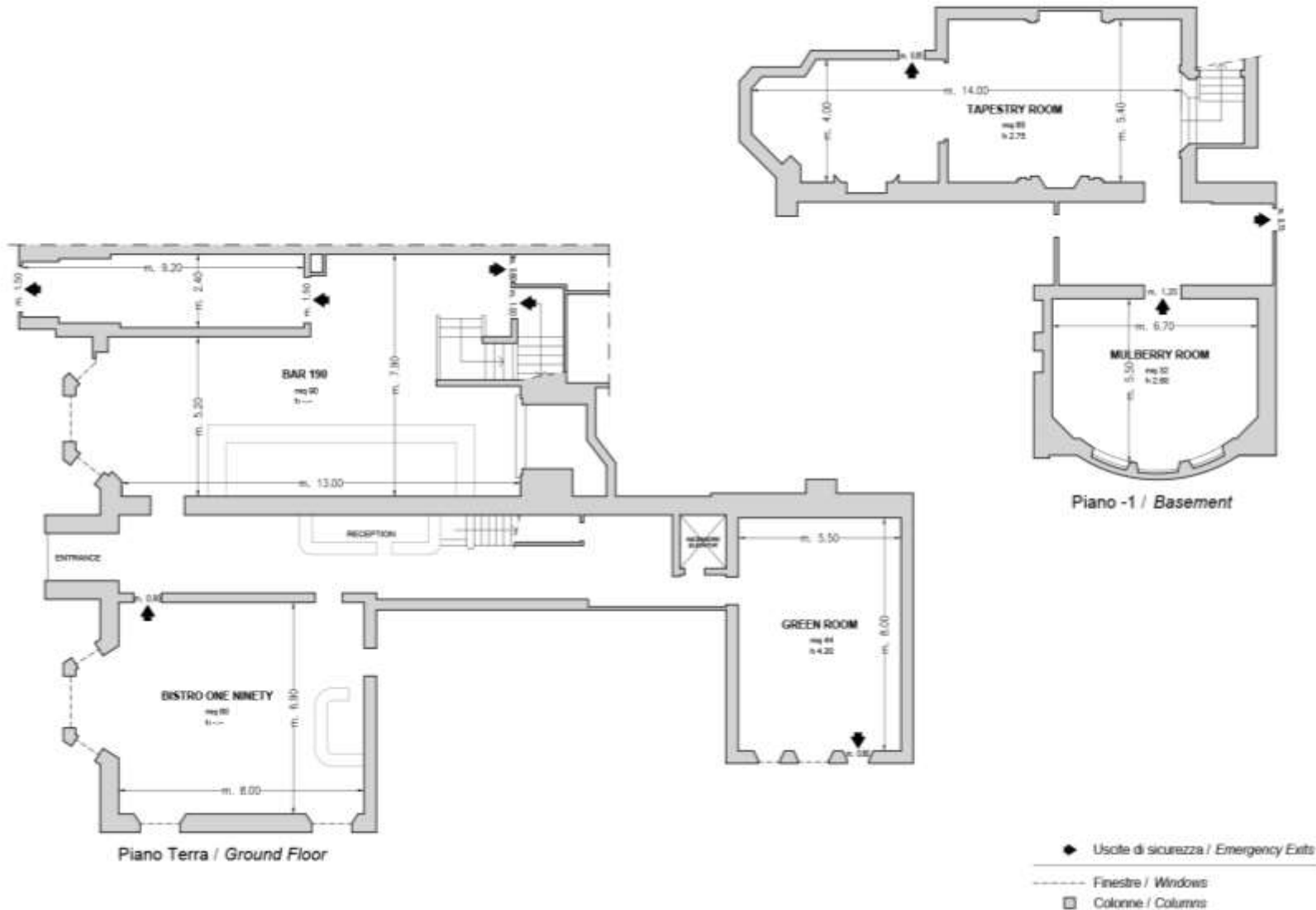
The Gore is just around the corner from the Royal Albert Hall which makes it the perfect place for pre- and post-theatre dining.
