










Destination


All the rooms and suites have an individual style and design, expressed by a unique mix of antique and modern furniture, paintings and precious fabrics.

The restaurant serves traditional-chic Italian food created with the distinctive flair of Michelin-starred chef Alfredo Russo.









Meeting & Events


From the classic meeting room - for seminars, presentations, a press conference or a board meeting - to the private dining room, for an exclusive gala dinner.
