

Starhotels presents the volume "Hotel d'Inghilterra" one year after the reopening of the legendary Roman landmark

Rome, September 24, 2025 – Exactly one year after its grand reopening on September 27, 2024, the **Hotel d'Inghilterra**, one of the jewels of **Starhotels Collezione**, celebrates its anniversary with the launch of "Hotel d'Inghilterra": a collector's book that traces the history and renaissance of this legendary address in the heart of Rome, highlighting its profound bond with the Eternal City and the renovation journey that has restored the property to its original splendor.

With its long-standing tradition of hospitality, the Hotel d'Inghilterra, located on Via Bocca di Leone just steps from Piazza di Spagna and Via Condotti, tells a story dating back to the mid-17th century. Originally known as the "Locanda d'Angleterre", it quickly became a favorite stop for European aristocrats and intellectuals on their Grand Tour. Over the centuries, the hotel welcomed celebrated Italian and international figures who contributed to its enduring myth: from Oscar Wilde to Ernest Hemingway, from Italo Calvino to Giuseppe Ungaretti, and cinema icons such as Elizabeth Taylor, Audrey Hepburn, and Sir Alec Guinness.

The recent restoration of the Hotel d'Inghilterra was a meticulous conservation project, guided by archival research and entrusted to outstanding Italian artisans, brought together by Starhotels under its patronage initiative "La Grande Bellezza – The Dream Factory". Among the highlights, master restorers Fersini Restauro, based just steps from the hotel, revived the original beauty of frames and furnishings, gilded with leaves supplied by historic Florentine manufacturer Giusto Manetti Battiloro. An extraordinary showcase of Italian savoir-faire, where tradition, innovation, and culture seamlessly converge.

Today, one year after its reopening, the Hotel d'Inghilterra reaffirms its spirit: not merely a refined retreat, but a meeting point between past and future, where guests can live a truly contemporary Grand Tour experience. Completely renovated and enriched by new outlets - the Cafè Romano restaurant, the Spa Suite - the hotel combines its historical soul with a new dimension of hospitality, where Rome itself seems to flow into its halls and rooms, "furnishing" its spaces, all the way up to the recently opened Terrazza Romana, which offers magnificent views over the rooftops and domes of the Eternal City.

"I am delighted to celebrate this milestone with a book that captures the soul of this historic palace, the intense yet rewarding restoration, and the end result: the rebirth of Hotel d'Inghilterra, offering a glimpse into the beauty of the city it overlooks from a privileged position, just a few steps from Piazza di Spagna," said Elisabetta Fabri, Starhotels' President and CEO.

The volume "Hotel d'Inghilterra" is part of the Grand Tour Collection, a publishing project that journeys through Italy alongside Starhotels, telling the stories and identities of places that have shaped the art of hospitality, true guardians of memory, art, and culture. Following the success of the first book dedicated to Helvetia & Bristol in Florence, this second volume further confirms Starhotels' dedication to preserving and showcasing Italy's historical and cultural heritage. The next volume in the series will be dedicated to Hotel Gabrielli in Venice.
