

## The Gore London Celebrates English Wine Week

*A curated programme including a dedicated English wine menu, collaborative events and pairing dinners*



*London, June 2nd 2026* - This June, The Gore London – Starhotels Collezione, one of London’s leading destinations for English wine, will celebrate English Wine Week with a specially curated programme dedicated to showcasing the exceptional quality, craftsmanship and growing prestige of English winemaking. Running from Saturday 20th to Sunday 28th June 2026, the historic Kensington hotel will present a series of immersive dining experiences alongside a bespoke English wine list served throughout the week, spotlighting some of the country’s most exciting vineyards and producers.

### **The English Wine Curation**

*20th - 28th June 2026*

Available throughout English Wine Week, guests will also be able to enjoy a dedicated English wine menu in both the restaurant and the bar, featuring a carefully curated selection of sparkling, white, orange and red wines from leading English vineyards across Sussex, Kent and Devon.

Highlights include Squerryes Brut from Kent, Artelium Blanc de Blancs from Sussex, Sharpham’s “Don’t Feed the Ponies” orange wine from Devon and Artelium Pinot Noir. The menu will also feature a flight of three wines of choice for £45. The menu also offers a selection of British-inspired small plates including hot cocktail chorizo, prawn tempura and grilled ciabatta with smoked aubergine purée.

With English wine continuing to gain international recognition for both quality and innovation, The Gore’s English Wine Week programme offers guests the opportunity to discover the diversity and sophistication of modern English winemaking within an iconic London setting.



## **Digby x Neal's Yard Cheese & Wine Pairing Evening**

*Wednesday 24th June 2026*

In collaboration with English sparkling wine house Digby Fine English and the renowned British cheesemongers Neal's Yard Dairy, The Gore will host an intimate cheese and wine pairing evening on Wednesday 24th June, exploring the relationship between English terroir, artisan production and seasonal flavour.

The evening will begin with a welcome glass of Digby sparkling wine, before guests are guided through a curated series of British cheese selections paired with a range of Digby cuvées, including the 2014 Vintage Reserve Brut, 2018 Vintage Rosé Brut and Blanc de Blancs.

Throughout the evening, guests will hear insights into the pairings, production methods and tasting notes from the teams behind both the wines and cheeses, before continuing the evening with further selections available throughout the night.

## **Artelium Wine Pairing Dinner**

*Friday 26th June 2026*

On Friday 26th June, The Gore will partner with Sussex-based producer Artelium Wine Estate for a four-course wine pairing dinner celebrating modern English winemaking alongside seasonal British ingredients. The evening will begin with a welcome reception in the hotel's Library featuring Artelium Blanc de Blancs and canapés, before guests move into the restaurant for a specially designed menu designed by Head Chef Frederick Forster MCA, paired with a selection of Artelium wines.

Courses will include warm Norfolk blackleg chicken vol-au-vent with English pea velouté and summer truffles, Loch Duart salmon raviolo with trout roe caviar sauce, and roasted saddle of Suffolk lamb paired with Artelium's Artefact 9 Cabernet Noir.

The experience will conclude with a summer trifle served alongside Loxwood Festival, Artelium's off-dry honey wine.
